Our skill is to ensure early identification and to work with parents and carers to support their child's needs, through our own interventions or with the assistance of appropriate outside agencies.

We will also ensure that we develop our more able pupils in whatever area they show prowess, either academically, physically, artistically, musically or socially. Our curriculum is inclusive to all faiths, beliefs, cultures and children.

We develop a learning community with an exciting, supportive environment and facilitators who develop active learning with interactive teaching promoting sustainable, lifelong transversal competencies, knowledge and skills especially in digital information technology, which will take the child through to adulthood and sustain them in the future world they will function in as an adult.
