We hope that this overview of this term's topic will provide you with ideas of how to help your child with their learning.

This term our main topic will be:

Katie Morag.

Literacy

We will be reading a variety of Katie Morag by the Mairi Hedderwick.

Flip Learning Task: Who is Mairi Hedderwick and where is she from? Find out all about her.

- Encourage your child to talk about the stories What is their favourite part? Who is their favourite character and why? Can they retell the story by using the pictures!
- Visit the library to look for Katie Morag stories perhaps you might find an alternative version of the story! How about information books about Scotland?

To help with reading and writing:

- Read with your child every day and discuss the story and ask questions about it.
- Practise correct letter formation.
- Build sentences using key words and write them down using a capital letter and full stop.
- Practice spelling challenges given. (These are available to download on our website.)

Science

We will continue to learn about a variety of plants and seasonal changes. We will also be learning about habitats and food chains.

Art

We will be exploring seascapes by Alfred Wallace, Andy Warhol and Magritte. Useful links to explore are below.
