Look at a person's uniform— what job do they do? Why is their job important in our community?

What job would you like to do when you are older? Why?

By the end of the unit I should ...

- Understand and talk about what these jobs involve and how they are similar/ different.
- Be able to name the people who help us at home and school. E.g.. The teacher, the lollipop person, the doctor.
- Know who helps keep us safe, healthy and provides food.

- Talk about past and present events in my life and experiences of friends and/or family. E.g. when I went to the doctors... My auntie called the fire service...
